RICHLAND COUNTY FAIR GO KART RACING RULES

OLNEY, IL

(Adopted 6/29/2023)

GENERAL RULES:

- 1. All junior drivers must be accompanied by an adult.
- 2. All drivers must wear helmets with shield or goggles, long sleeves, long pants, neck brace, gloves, & closed toed shoes.
- 3. Hoods should be tucked in and long hair tied and tucked in for safety.
- 4. All classes, except SBO, are open to tech checks.
- 5. All karts must be flat karts with bumpers on the front and rear, as well as nerf bars (bumpers) on each side.
- 6. All karts need a visible number on the front or right side of the kart.

JR. 1 CLASS

- 1. Ages 10 & Under.
- 2. Green restrictor plate (0.425) with a 265 lb. minimum **OR** red restrictor plate (0.375) with a 250 lb. minimum.
- 3. May run clone or predator.
- 4. 10.8 lb. valve springs.

JR. 3 CLASS

- 1. Ages 10 15.
- 2. Blue restrictor plate (0.550) with a 320 lb. minimum **OR** purple restrictor plate (0.500) with a 290 lb. minimum.
- 3. May run clone or predator.
- 4. 10.8 lb. valve springs.

BOX STOCK (Predator 212 Only)

- 1. 350 lb. minimum.
- 2. Drum style clutches only.
- 3. Slick tires only.
- 4. May add clutch/chain guard.
- 5. May add side mount throttle linkage plate.
- 6. May remove throttle stop screw.
- 7. May drill vent hole in gas cap.
- 8. Gasoline only 87 octane.
- 9. No other modifications allowed.
- 10. Must pass engine RPM rev test. 5600 for Hemi, 6100 nonhemi.

SUPER STOCK

- 1. !! \$400 Claim Policy !!
- 2. 350 lb. minimum.
- 3. May run any 6.5 hp style engine block.
- 4. Must run 22 lb valve springs max.
- 5. Max carb venturi size of 0.615.
- 6. Max main jet of 0.039.

- 7. Must run on gasoline.
- 8. Open clutch/tire rules.
- 9. Claim Policy: If you win a feature event, immediately following the race, last place to second plate will have the option to claim your engine for \$400 on engine swap. If you do not have anyone claim your engine, you are still subject to tech check following the rules above. If someone does claim your engine, you will get \$400 and will be allowed to keep your clutch and clutch guard. If you have custom valve cover or blower housing, you may keep those as well if you can provide stock replacements. If you deny a claim on your engine, you will be disqualified from further participation in the Super Stock Class.

SMALL BLOCK OPEN

- 1. 350 lb. minimum.
- 2. Open engine, clutch and tire rules.
- 3. Must be able to keep pace with the field and race safely.

LADIES CLASS

- 1. Girls and women only.
- 2. Small block open rules (may use any class engine).
- 3. Must be able to keep pace with the field and race safely.

50+ CLASS

- 1. Driver must be 50 years or older.
- 2. Small block open rules (may use any class engine)
- 3. Must be able to keep pace with the field and race safely.

If found not following the listed rules in either, you will automatically be disqualified. You will NOT RECEIVE A REFUND! All judges' decisions are final.
